



2023 Cache Valley Cheese and Dairy Festival Best Cheesecake in the County Contest Rules



Contestants must use cream cheese we provide (courtesy of Schreiber Foods). Each contestant will receive 32 ounces of cream cheese for their delicious creation. You can pick up your cream cheese at the Cache County Event Center 490 W. 500 S. in Logan from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Sept. 25-27.

Bakers ages 8 and older are welcome to enter, and you must be a Cache County resident.

Your cheesecake must measure between 6-9 inches in diameter.

Cheesecakes must be made from scratch (no mixes).

Bonus points for including additional *purchased* Cache Valley products in the recipe (berries from your yard or eggs from your chickens don't qualify).

Judging Criteria

Taste/flavor	30 points
Texture	25 points
Originality	25 points
Appearance	20 points

Bonus for including local ingredients: 2 points each; 5 bonus items max

TOTAL 100 points

First place wins prizes and the auspicious title of Best Cheesecake in the County. Awards and prizes for second and third place as well as honorable mention will also be presented. All prizes are courtesy of Schreiber Foods.

Drop off your entry at the Cache County Event Center Thursday, Sept. 28 from 4-6 p.m. You must provide a copy of your recipe, including measurements. Judging begins at 6 p.m. Winners will be contacted by noon Friday, Sept. 29. Winner will be publicly announced and awards presented Saturday, Sept. 30 at noon from the Festival stage. You must be present to claim your award and prize.

Legal Stuff: By participating in this contest, entrants agree to be bound by these official rules and to the judges' decisions, which are final and binding on all matters relating to the contest. Entrants must enter as an individual. Entrants under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign their submission at the time of entry. All submitted recipes will become property of the Cache County Event Center and may be used for promotion and advertising for the Cache Valley Cheese and Dairy Festival without remuneration and in perpetuity.
